Part Time

As a part time student there will be one semester during your course where you will need to devote three days to the programme. For DN's this is usually in the first year in semester one. To make up for this, you will need to spend only one day in practice during the summer of your first year.

If you are already a nurse prescriber, you will APL this into the programme and are not required to take another module in its place.

Trimester One ONE day in university, ONE in practice	Using Evidence and Information (Tuesday)
Trimester Two One day in university, ONE in practice	Leading and Organising Specialist Practice (Monday)
Trimester Three ***FULL TIME in practice this is non-negotiable NMC requirement for all students	Consolidation of Practice attendance at study days (Alternate Tuesdays and Thursdays)
