Rockford Fields (also known locally as Rockford Meadow) is situated north of Lamorna Avenue allotments, east of Foredyke Avenue (Foredyke Stream Cycle Route), west of the Trans-Pennine trail (Hull to Hornsea Cycle Route) and south of Lindengate Avenue. The site is bound on three sides by residential development and forms an important link in Hull's green network.
