This major new book provides a pioneering region-wide appraisal of the scale, character and significance of the North Atlantic fisheries down to the mid-nineteenth century. Written by experts in the field, including James E. Candow, Alf R Nielsen, Ernesto Lopez Losa and Robb Robinson, the study assesses how and why the region's fisheries have contributed significantly to human dietary requirements, generated income for those engaged in the catching, processing and marketing of fish products, and encouraged fishers – and their techniques, beliefs and cultures - to migrate to new lands in search of better catches and markets.
