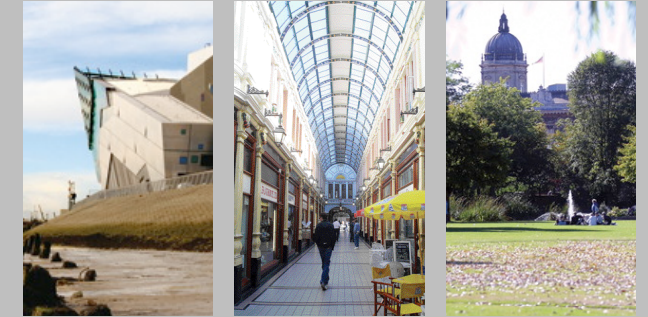

Afternoon at leisure...

After lunch, your group will be able to spend the afternoon at their leisure.

Why not combine your visit with a ticket to Hull's award-winning attraction, The Deep, the world's first submrium and home to over 3,000 fish and 7 species of shark. An exclusive, discounted admission rate of £5 per person is available to groups when booking a Shop Ahoy! package. Tickets must be booked in advance with Hull Tourism.

The city boasts a further eight museums, all with FREE admission. The Museums Quarter, situated in the heart of the historic Old Town, is an excellent starting point, linking the Streetlife Museum, the Hull and East Riding Museum, Wilberforce House and the Arctic Corsair*.

If time permits, don't miss the Hull Maritime Museum, Ferens Art Gallery, the Hands on History Museum and the Spurn Lightship*, moored in the city's delightful marina.

**Please note, these attractions are unsuitable for people with mobility problems. Open April to October, subject to weather conditions. Please check before your visit to avoid disappointment.*

If shopping is more your style, visit the Princes Quay and Prospect Shopping centres. Hull's newest retail development, St Stephen's, is due for completion at the end of 2007 - bringing even greater retail choice to the city.



A Festive Note...

A Christmas Shop Ahoy! package is available from mid-November, running through December 2007. It adopts a similar itinerary to the standard trip, with morning coffee upon arrival and choice of guided walks, but includes a festive buffet lunch at The Mission or Portland Hotel, with all the trimmings, mince pies and coffee.

The trip is priced from £9.95 per person, with a minimum of 10. One free place offered per group.

Make the most of your stay...

Hull has a good selection of hotels catering for groups. If you are interested in extending your day trip to include an overnight stay, we can find competitive accommodation rates on your behalf. Please ask!

Hull provides any group with the perfect touring base for exploring the stunning area of East Yorkshire. Within 15 minutes' drive of Hull, you will find the beautiful countryside of the Yorkshire Wolds and some delightful market towns. At its heart is the bustling market town of Beverley, with impressive architecture, including the majestic Beverley Minster, and interesting speciality shops and craft arcades.

Alternatively, head south from Hull over the Humber Bridge and the county of Lincolnshire awaits you. Lincoln is a magnificent cathedral city with much to offer. The formalities

- Minimum number of 10 people.
- Provisional numbers are to be confirmed by the group organiser to Hull Tourism, fourteen days prior to trip taking place.

- Payment for the trip is to be made on the day, to the tour guide.
- Cancellation of all or part of the bookings, made after final numbers have been provided, must be paid for in full.

The Tour Options

NEW for 2007

Walking with Wilberforce

Created to commemorate the 200th anniversary since the abolition of the slave trade, this new tour looks at Wilberforce the man and his links with Hull. Visit the church where he was baptised, Holy Trinity, and his first school, the Old Grammar School (Hands on History Museum). Then spend time in his birthplace, now Wilberforce House Museum, re-opening on the 25th March 2007, after a £1.6 million refurbishment.

The Original Shop Ahoy!

Take a journey through 800 years of Hull's fascinating history to discover some of the city's hidden secrets and enjoy exciting tales of days gone by. The route will take in High Street - in the heart of the Old Town and home to the Museums Quarter, Hull Marina, Victoria Pier, Trinity Square and the many hidden alleyways and courtyards.

Walking or coach tour.

A Fish Called UMBER

Explore the sights of Hull by following its special fish pavement – the Seven Seas Fish Trail. It's great fun for everyone and the perfect way of discovering the city's new and old towns and its magnificent waterfront. There are 41 fish lurking amongst the city centre pavements; will your group be able to locate them all? Look out for the electric eel outside the electricity substation and the shark basking outside the bank. Your English Heritage accredited tour guide will be on hand to lead you along your way, and a certificate will be awarded to everyone successfully completing the trail.

The Hull Tapestry and Guildhall Tour

Enjoy a guided tour of the city's historic Guildhall and see Hull's answer to the Bayeux Tapestry. Sixteen years in the making, Hull Tapestry illustrates the history and achievements of the city of Hull over the past 700 years. Each panel contains thousands of stitches, ranging from basic tent stitch to the exotically named encroaching Gobelin!

2007 will see the completion of the tapestry, when the final five panels go on display. So book now and be one of the first to enjoy the tapestry in its entirety.

The Guildhall tour includes visits to the Council Chamber and the Lord Mayor's Suites (subject to availability), along with the civic silver and insignia, artwork and sculptures.

A Place for Reflection

Escape from the hectic pace of life and discover Hull's distinctive city centre churches. This guided tour will take your group to a maximum of three churches from St. Mary the Virgin, Hull's oldest, church dating back to the 13th century; Holy Trinity, England's largest parish church, featuring medieval brickwork and impressive stained-glass windows; Charterhouse Chapel, a rare example of Georgian ecclesiastical architecture; and St Charles Borromeo, the city's main Catholic church, with Italian Renaissance-style interior.

Green City

One of Hull's oldest parks, Pearson Park is situated in an architectural conservation area and was once home to the poet Philip Larkin. The tour includes a visit to the Victorian conservatory, housing tropical plants, birds, fish and snakes.

Your options...

The following options are available to tailor your day trip to Hull to suit the requirements of your group.

Morning coffee and biscuits

Choose from:

Hotel Elizabeth Ideally situated 10 minutes from Hull city centre, adjacent to the A63, the hotel offers spectacular views of the river and Humber Bridge.

The Mission Located in the heart of Hull's historic Old Town, The Mission originally opened its doors in 1926 as a Mission to Seamen. The building re-opened as a public house in 1995. Coffee is served in the splendour of the Old Chapel.

The Portland Hotel Centrally located, the hotel is just a few minutes' walk from Princes Quay Shopping Centre and Hull's Old Town.

The Hotel Campanile Located on the fringe of the city centre, the hotel has good transport access. Coffee is served in their French-style bistro.

Pearson Park Hotel Delightfully situated within the city's oldest park, Pearson Park, just a few minutes' drive from the city centre.

Lunch

Decide between:

The Mission Hot and cold buffet or fish and chips with bread and butter and mushy peas. Tea and coffee included.

The Portland Hotel Hot and cold buffet, which includes one traditional hot dish. Tea and coffee included.

Pearson Park Hotel A variety of buffet menus are available, ranging from sandwich options to a full fork buffet. Prices for a day-trip package with lunch at the Pearson Park Hotel start from £11.50 per person, depending upon the chosen menu option. Details available on request.

Please note that the venues serving lunch are only able to offer one menu selection to the whole group. Please remember to inform Hull Tourism at the time of booking of any special dietary requirements.
