The Right Honourable Alan Johnson was General Secretary of the Communication Workers Union before entering Parliament as Labour MP for Hull West and Hessle in 1997. He held a variety of cabinet positions in the Blair and Brown governments including Home Secretary, Health Secretary and Education Secretary. He also served as Shadow Chancellor of the Exchequer under Miliband. Alan retired before the 2017 general election after 20 years as an MP.

His childhood memoir 'This Boy' was published by Bantam Press in 2013. It won the Royal Society of Literature Ondaatje Prize and the Orwell Prize, Britain's top political writing award. His second volume of memoirs, 'Please, Mister Postman', was published in 2014 and won the National Book Club award for Best Biography. The final book in his memoir trilogy, 'The Long and Winding Road', was published in 2016 and won the Parliamentary Book Award for Best Memoir. A fourth memoir about his love of music, 'In My Life – A Music Memoir', was published in 2018 followed by his first novel, 'The Late Train to Gipsy Hill' in 2021. His subsequent novels include 'One of Our Ministers is Missing' and 'Death on the Thames'. Alan's latest work, the biography 'Harold Wilson: Twentieth Century Man: The Prime Minister Series' was published in late 2024.

Alan has appeared regularly on television including the BBC's 'This Week' with Andrew Neil and Michael Portillo and alongside Steph McGovern on Channel 4's 'Steph's Packed Lunch'.

He was appointed Chancellor of the University of Hull in June 2023.

He lives in East Yorkshire with his wife Carolyn.

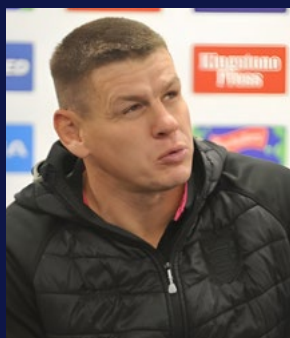

His leadership is known for its entrepreneurial vision and commitment to the region and is recognised for his dedication to regional business growth.



Lee Radford

Doctor of Letters, *Honoris Causa*

Born in East Hull and shaped by the community he grew up in, Lee Radford began his rugby league journey at David Lister School before signing with Hull FC as their youngest-ever first-team player. His distinguished career spans Super League titles, Challenge Cup victories, more than 300 senior appearances and international honours for England.

After retiring, Lee became a highly respected coach - from leading Hull FC to consecutive Challenge Cup triumphs, to roles with Castleford Tigers, the Dallas Jackals and Samoa Rugby League. His move into rugby union saw immediate success, helping Northampton Saints secure the Premiership, before being appointed Scotland's defence coach in 2025. He is honoured for his outstanding contribution to sport and community development.

Lesley Gracie

Doctor of Letters, *Honoris Causa*

Lesley Gracie is the master distiller at Hendrick's Gin and is responsible for creating the original Hendrick's Gin recipe and for every liquid innovation from Hendrick's ever since.

Born and raised in Hull, Lesley studied chemistry at Hull Technical College whilst working for a pharmaceutical company in the city. Lesley has always been enchanted by plants and one of her first roles involved playing with botanical flavours to mask the taste of medicines.

In 1999, while working at in the lab at William Grant & Sons' Girvan Distillery developing different innovative liquids, Lesley was approached by the great grandson of William Grant, Charlie Gordon, to create a bold new gin unlike anything which had come before. Hendrick's Gin was the result, helping to spark a ginnaisance across the globe.

Over the past two decades, Lesley has been responsible for countless pioneering releases and has amassed an array of botanicals, distillates and experimental liquids in her lab at the Hendrick's Gin Palace. Lesley Gracie has a long history of pushing boundaries with her experiments, her genius lies in her fascination with flavours and how they work together. She visualises flavours as shapes and strikes to create a round, balanced flavour in all of her experimental elixirs.



Willie Peters

Wednesday 17 December | 4.30pm

Willie Peters is the Head Coach of Hull KR and has played a central role in one of the most remarkable chapters in the club's history. This year, he guided Hull KR to an extraordinary treble - Challenge Cup victory, the League Leaders' Shield, and a decisive win over Wigan following their Super League Grand Final clash. His leadership also earned him the Super League Coach of the Year award and a position as Assistant Head Coach for the Australian national team.

Willie will receive an Honorary Doctor of Letters at the University following the premiere of Renaissance, a new documentary charting Hull KR's rise from relegation in 2016 to their record-breaking season.

Proud history of Teacher Education

From its founding, the University of Hull has had educational-development at its core. Adult Education was one of the founding departments of the University, coming formally into existence on 1st January 1928. The University's first appointed Professor was in Adult Education.

The Department offered the majority of its programmes to local students, mostly off-campus and often part-time, with large programmes in Beverley, York, Grimsby, Scunthorpe and Scarborough and smaller offerings, often in response to student demand, sometimes through partnership with the Workers Educational Association, in up to a hundred villages in East Yorkshire and on the south bank of the Humber. The School of Education at the University of Hull still engages with an extensive network of Colleges across the region, enabling the delivery of degrees to students in their own locality and with a very similar reach and has an extensive series of partnerships with a very diverse range of organisations.

Teacher education has its roots in delivery both in Hull and at the Scarborough campus. Initially intending teachers gained a Certificate in Education (Cert Ed) before moves in the 1980s to offer undergraduate degrees in Education notably through a Bachelor of Education (B Ed) degree. Over the years, teacher education developed to offer qualifications across the primary, secondary and tertiary phases of Education.

Most recently, the School of Education has taken an innovative approach to preparing future teachers through two-year accelerated degrees in both Primary and Secondary Teaching Studies, which prepare students to undertake a PGCE. This is one facet of the work of a School of Education that offers undergraduate and Masters level programmes across a broad range of areas including Early Childhood, Education Studies, Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL), Youth Work, Community Engagement, Social Justice, Leadership and Management and Special Educational Needs Disabilities and Inclusion.

In September 2023, the first Rosalind Hollis Professor of Education for Social Justice was appointed. This post recognises a past graduate of the University, who gave a generous bequest from her estate. Rosalind G. Hollis (1931 – 2021) studied Mathematics at the University of Hull, undertaking teaching practice at Hunmanby Hall Methodist Boarding School in Filey in her final year. Throughout her adult life she was involved in work with children through both teaching and volunteering, authoring a dozen textbooks on Maths education.

In order to celebrate our history and heritage in the field of Education, the University is granting the award of Honorary Bachelor of Education to those who attained a Certificate in Education from the University of Hull in the 1980s and earlier. These students would, in later times, have been awarded a full undergraduate degree, and we recognise and celebrate their studies and subsequent achievements. Those receiving an honorary degree have variously made significant and sustained contributions to their communities, to schools and settings and to industry in the UK and around the world during the past six decades.

The University robes

The academic dress of gown, cap and hood, which is worn by graduates, University officers and members of the academic procession, dates from medieval times.

Officers' dress

The **Chancellor, Pro-Chancellors** and **Vice-Chancellor** wear robes of blue damask silk, trimmed with gold lace. The Chancellor's sleeves are decorated with traditional ornamentation. Their caps are square, of black silk velvet, trimmed with a gold lace band and with gold bullion buttons and black (Vice-Chancellor) or gold tassels. **Pro-Vice-Chancellors** wear the dress robes of their degrees and square caps of black silk velvet, trimmed with silver lace bands with silver bullion buttons and black silk tassels.

Academic dress

Foundation degree candidates wear black gowns of the undergraduate pattern with **diploma** hoods, which are a different pattern from those of the Bachelors and Masters. **Certificate** and **Diploma** candidates (including Certificate in Education candidates) wear gowns of the undergraduate pattern. **Bachelors** and **Masters** wear black gowns with different sleeve styles depending on the degree being conferred. Their hoods are black and lined with the University silk – turquoise blue taffeta. The yoke of the Masters' hood is square and edged with the University silk. The hood of the **Masters of Music** is cream silk brocade. Their caps are black cloth mortar boards with black silk tassels. **Doctorates** in full dress wear a claret-coloured robe and hood, and a round cap of black cloth with cord and tassels, which are the same colour as the robe. **Doctors of Music** wear a robe and hood of cream silk brocade. The sleeves and the fronts of both robes are of the University silk. Higher Doctorates and Doctors honoris causa wear a scarlet robe and hood, with sleeves and fronts of the University silk. Their cap is round, of black velvet, with cord and tassels, which are the same colour as the robe. Professional Graduate Certificate in Education candidates wear a black gown and mortar board, black hood with three-inch turquoise blue edging. Postgraduate Certificate in Education candidates wear a black gown and mortar board, black hood with turquoise blue lining.

Hull York Medical School robes

Undergraduates and Masters wear black University of Hull gowns at the graduation ceremony. The caps worn are square, of the mortar-board pattern, of black cloth with black silk tassel.

BMedSci candidates wear a black gown of the undergraduate pattern with a black hood lined with turquoise blue silk, cowl edge faced inside with dark blue silk. **BSc MedSci** candidates wear a black gown of the undergraduate pattern with a black hood lined with dark blue silk, cowl edge faced inside with turquoise blue and orange silk. **MBBS** candidates wear a black gown of the undergraduate pattern with a black hood lined with dark blue silk, cowl edge faced inside with turquoise blue and orange silk. **MSc (Taught and Research Masters)** candidates wear a black Hull Masters postgraduate gown. The hood is full shaped with a black outer, lined with orange and faced inside cowl edge with turquoise blue. The cape edge is faced outside with dark blue and the neck band is black bound with turquoise blue on the top edge and dark blue on the bottom edge. MPhil (Research Masters) candidates wear a black Hull Masters postgraduate gown. The hood is a full shape with maroon outer lining and bound with dark blue. The inside cowl edge is faced with turquoise blue and the neck band is bound with maroon with turquoise blue on the top edge and dark blue on the bottom edge.

PhD (Research Doctorate) candidates wear a maroon gown with facings of dark blue and orange and sleeves faced with dark blue and top edged with orange. The hood is a full shape with a maroon outer, lined and bound with dark blue. The cowl edge is faced inside with turquoise blue and maroon and the neck band maroon, bound with turquoise blue on the top edge and dark blue on the bottom edge. The cap is a maroon bonnet with turquoise blue cord and tassels. MD (Taught Doctorate) candidates wear a dark blue gown with facings of turquoise blue and orange and sleeves faced with turquoise blue and top edged with orange. The hood is a full shape with a dark blue outer, lined and bound with turquoise blue. The cowl edge is faced inside with orange, and the neck band is bound with dark blue with orange on the top edge and turquoise blue on the bottom edge. The cap is a dark blue cloth bonnet with turquoise blue cord and tassels.

The ceremonial landmark

Our coat of arms is a hallmark of quality and a badge of honour. A symbol for a time-trusted education that prepares you for doing what's right and true: for you, for society, for the world.

Originally designed in 1928, our coat of arms has been updated for our upcoming centenary and beyond. The emblems of old are still here, and each has its own meaning: the torch embodies our motto *Lampada Ferens*, translated as 'carrying the light of learning'; the dove is a sign of peace and comes from the arms of Thomas Ferens, one of our founding benefactors; the wave acknowledges the importance of our home on the Humber; the ducal coronet comes from the coat of arms for the City of Hull; the rose represents Yorkshire; and the fleur-de-lys symbolises Lincolnshire.
