We are looking to begin recruitment for our recurring 48 week Year In Industry Placement students for the 25/26 academic year. The placements will begin at the end of September 2025 and conclude at the end of August 2026.

The placements are based in Lincolnshire at RAF Waddington and RAF Coningsby in the Operational Research teams in ASWC HQ and 41 Test and Evaluation Squadron respectively. Three placements are available for students currently enrolled on a Bachelors or Master's degree Programme with at least one academic year of study remaining after completion of the placement.

These placements are open to any and all STEM degree disciplines, with the successful candidates being people with inherent technical curiosity, sound problem solving and logical thinking skills. An appreciation of statistics and either a fundamental level of scientific knowledge or IT and coding skills are desirable.





What is Operational Research?

Operational Research applies **scientific methods** and **undertakes analysis** into **defence questions** to provide the evidence which informs military decision makers.



- Work directly alongside armed forces personnel to supply advice and analysis on technical issues generated by any RAF activity, from training exercises to humanitarian relief and operations across the globe.
- Participate in the planning and technical analysis of RAF equipment trials including all aspects of in-service UK aircraft and weapons.
- Assist with the modelling and performance analysis of air power technologies and their implementation in tactics.
- Create statistical and scientific models to simulate, extrapolate and predict future RAF performance capabilities.
- Support studies into air power concept and capability development.



Any and all STEM degree disciplines are welcome. Current placement students are working towards degrees in Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics and Engineering.

An inherent curiosity, sound problem solving and logical thinking skills, an appreciation of statistics and either a fundamental level of scientific knowledge or IT and coding skills are desirable.

Good communication skills to work efficiently in a dynamic mixed civilian and military team environment, experience of managing and manipulating data and the ability to work autonomously whilst managing tasks and projects are beneficial. Further technical and specialist training will be provided.

Thank you for coming back to us and agreeing to take part in industry week for our 1st year Computer Science students. The session will take place on Wednesday 8th May 2024 and is scheduled to start at 1pm and will be approximately 2 hours in length, although this depends on how many employers we have attending and also includes some networking time too.

The format will be more presentation based, with the opportunity to provide an overview of BAE Systems and the teams you look to recruit Computer Science students into. An overview of the types of opportunities that you usually look to recruit to and the types of skills sets you are after would also be useful, along with your recruitment process and the dates your adverts usually go live.

The presentation slot is approximately 15 minutes which should also include Q&A element, although we're flexible around this, so if you can aim for around 10 minutes of presenting that would be great. I expect to have 3 other employers in attendance, so that will likely take up the first half of the session.

We'll then follow this with networking, including refreshments, where students can speak to guest speakers on an individual or group basis for any further specific questions they may have, but to also hopefully improve their confidence with networking. As part of one of the first year modules, students will have completed a CV and we are also advising they bring this along and ask for some quick fire feedback from those attending the session, including yourselves, our Central Careers Team, and Academic Staff who will be attending.

All I need at this stage is a confirmation that this works for you and then I can get your place booked. I just need names of those who would be taking part along with how many parking spaces you need reserving, along with names and licence plate numbers so we can get the parking permits setup and sent over. It would also be useful to know if any attendees also have any dietary or access requirements that need to be considered too at this stage, if you can also provide those.
