

Evidence of Name Change

The University of Hull uses its best endeavours to ensure that documents presented by new students are genuine, to safeguard the institution against attempts to gain false entry to a programme, or gain financial benefit from student status, or gain a visa for entry to the UK using false means.

When providing evidence of your qualifications, if the given name on that information is different to the name of the applicant, you must provide an appropriate form of evidence to support the change of name.

Examples of appropriate evidence are

- A marriage certificate
- Change of name deed
- Solicitor's letter
