

UCAS Tariff Points from three A Levels or equivalent

Eligibility for the Attainment Scholarship and Merit Scholarship is determined based on qualifications equivalent to three A Levels only. For example, three A Levels, a BTEC Extended Diploma, or an Access to HE Diploma.

Additional qualifications will not be included, for example three A Levels plus an AS Level/EPQ, or an Access to HE Diploma plus an A Level.

UCAS assigns each Level 3 qualification a size band, and this is how we determine what qualifications are equivalent to an A Level. Qualifications at other levels do not attract UCAS Tariff points, so will not be taken into account when assessing scholarship eligibility.

A BTEC Subsidiary Diploma is equivalent to one A Level, a BTEC Diploma is equivalent to two A Levels, and a BTEC Extended Diploma is equivalent to three A Levels.

Each element of the International Baccalaureate diploma programme attracts UCAS Tariff points individually. Each Higher level subject is equivalent to one A Level.
